Call for Papers

The Organising Committee of the 18th International Cartographic Conference in Stockholm 1997 invites abstracts for papers proposed to be delivered as part of the scientific conference programme. The papers must address themselves to one or more of the following conference themes. Authors should indicate which theme is addressed, but the final decision on categorisation is reserved to the Organising Committee as part of its acceptance decision. The conference themes are:

1. Education and Training in Cartography
2. History of Cartography
3. Cartography for Environment
4. Marine Cartography of the Continental Shelf
5. Generalisation of Databases and Maps
6. National and Regional Atlases, Production and Use
7. Maps of Dynamic Processes
8. Cadastral Mapping in Transition Countries
9. Military Mapping
10. Mapping Crossing National Borders
11. Map Production
12. Quality in Cartography
13. Cartography as a Tool in Monitoring Agriculture and Forestry
14. Desk Top Mapping in Media
15. Cartographic Information in Navigation Systems
16. Law and Cartography
17. Mapping of Mountainous Areas
18. Maps for the Handicapped
19. Cartography and Children
20. Gender in Cartography
21. Visualisation Techniques
22. Cartographic Theory
23. Standardisation
24. GIS and Digital Mapping
25. National Mapping Organisations, Organisation and Strategic Programmes

The abstract should be 300-500 words long in English, the conference language. Use standard 21x29.7 cm paper with 4 cm top and bottom margins and 3 cm side margins, or use 8½x11 inch paper with 1½ inch top and bottom margins and 1¼ inch side margins. Center the title in bold capital letters as the first item, followed by a vertical space and then the name(s) of the author(s). Type the affiliation address (typed as it should appear on a mailing envelope) immediately below each author's name. Immediately below the last line, authors are encouraged (but not required) to include a fax number and/or e-mail address. After skipping two lines, the body of the abstract should be typed with single spacing and no indentation for paragraphs.

The abstracts must be received by the Conference Secretariate by **October 1, 1996**. You will then be notified of the acceptance decision as session paper or poster by December 1, 1996. The full version (max 8 pages) of the accepted paper or poster to be published in the conference proceedings must be received by the Scientific Programme Committee by March 15, 1997 at the latest. Only papers and posters received by this date are assured of publication in the proceedings.
